



## **NOTICE OF PROPERTY TAX INCREASE**

The Floyd County Board of Commissioners has tentatively adopted a 2022 millage rate which will require an increase in property taxes by 5.82%.

All concerned citizens are invited to the public hearing on this tax increase to be held in the Floyd County Commission chambers located at 12 East 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Rome, GA, on July 12, 2022, at 6:00 PM.

Times and places of additional public hearings on this tax increase are in the Floyd County Commission chambers located at 12 East 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Rome, GA, on July 26, 2022, at 8:00 AM and July 26, 2022, at 6:00 PM.

This tentative increase will result in a millage rate of 9.678 mills, an increase of .532 mills. Without this tentative tax increase, the millage rate will be no more than 9.146 mills. The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of \$200,000 is approximately \$53 and the proposed tax increase for non-homestead property with a fair market value of \$150,000 is approximately \$40.
