

## **NOTICE OF PROPERTY TAX INCREASE**

The Floyd County Board of Commissioners has tentatively adopted a 2024 millage rate which will require an increase in property taxes of 14.6%.

All concerned citizens are invited to the public hearing on this tax increase to be held in the Floyd County Commission chambers located at 12 East 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Rome, GA, on July 23, 2024, at 8:00 AM and 6:00 PM.

Notice is further given that a final vote on the millage rate will be taken at a special meeting of the Floyd County Board of Commissioners called for that purpose on July 30, 2024 at 8:00 AM in the Floyd County Commission chambers located at 12 East 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Rome, GA.

This tentative increase will result in a millage rate of 9.414 mills, an increase of 1.199 mills. Without this tentative tax increase, the millage rate will be no more than 8.215 mills. The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of \$250,000 is approximately \$128 and the proposed tax increase for non-homestead property with a fair market value of \$200,000 is approximately \$102.
